The Communicating Science Project

The Task: To explain and communicate information about a scientific concept to a specified audience.

What to do:

- Present a scientific concept using a communication medium eg: a model, a poster, a PowerPoint Presentation, a game etc.
- Create a Scientific Notebook and a written report about it.

Your written report should:

- clearly & briefly explain the scientific concept you have chosen. - include your background research information, references
- identify and describe the target audience eg: young students/ adults?
- justify your choice of communication medium for your target audience

What to do:

- ★ Include your background research information, references and permission to use copyrighted material (if applicable)
- ★ Identify and describe the target audience.
- ★ Show evidence of scientific research about topic.
- ★ Make it entertaining and informative!
- ★ Talk about your choice of communication medium for your target audience. In the journal explain why you made a model or game?
- ★ The presentation must not exceed an A2 size (594 x 420cm).
